

# Tree Replacement Programme

## *Creating Safer & Greener Estates Together*

The Town Councils, in collaboration with NParks and HDB, are implementing a tree replacement programme to enhance public safety and build a more resilient urban environment.

Many Khaya and Sea Apple trees, planted decades ago in our estates, have outgrown their planting verges, severely limiting the available space for root growth and affecting their long-term health. These species are prone to basal rot, which can compromise their structural stability.

Following a review of trees in our estates, Khaya and Sea Apple trees will be progressively replaced, prioritising those that show signs of disease, are in poor health or structural condition, exceed 2 metres in girth, or are growing near residential blocks or in limited planting space.

With climate change bringing more severe weather, these pre-emptive measures are important for public safety. Tree replacements will be carried out progressively, with affected trees being replaced with species better suited to our urban landscape. We will be mindful to reduce the disruptions to the residents during the process.

We seek residents' understanding as we work to enhance public safety and rejuvenate the estates. Thank you for your continued support.




