Service & Conservancy Charges (S&CC) Rebate for HDB Households

The rebate was announced during Budget 2026 to help households with expenses. Depending on the HDB flat type, eligible Singaporean households will receive between 1.5 and 3.5 months of S&CC rebate over financial year 2026.

Recycle Your Beverage Containers the Right Way!

Return Your Empty Containers and Get 10¢ Back for Every Return

The Beverage Container Return Scheme, launched on 1 April 2026, encourages everyone in Singapore to **"Return Right"** by returning their empty plastic and metal beverage containers at dedicated return points across Singapore.

By returning your empty containers, you not only help reduce waste and support recycling efforts — you will also receive a 10¢ refund for each eligible container returned.

How to Return Right?



1. Check that the container has the Deposit Mark



2. Keep barcode intact, don't crush container



3. Ensure container is empty



4. Insert one container at a time



5. Get 10¢ back for every return

What's Coming To Town?

Taman Jurong: Upgrading of Drop-off Point between Blocks 180 and 181 Yung Sheng Road

Residents of Yung Sheng Road can look forward to a more convenient and commuter-friendly environment with the upcoming upgrading of the drop-off point between Blocks 180 and 181 Yung Sheng Road.



Nanyang: Upgrading of Playground between Blocks 948 and 949

Families and residents in the neighbourhood can look forward to an upgraded playground between Blocks 948 and 949, bringing refreshed recreational spaces for children and the community to enjoy.

Jurong Spring-Gek Poh: Upgrading of Podium at Neighbourhood Park (Blocks 548 to 558, Jurong West Street 42)

Exciting enhancements await residents of Jurong Spring-Gek Poh with the upcoming upgrading of the podium at the neighbourhood park between Blocks 548 and 558, Jurong West Street 42.

The improvements aim to refresh the existing facility, creating a more welcoming and functional space for residents to gather, relax, and take part in community activities.



Boon Lay: Installation of High Volume Low Speed (HVLS) and Industrial Fans

Residents of Boon Lay can look forward to more comfortable community spaces with the installation of High Volume Low Speed (HVLS) and industrial fans across 19 multi-purpose halls and one covered games court.

This upgrade aims to improve ventilation and air circulation, creating a cooler and more pleasant environment for residents during activities and gatherings.

Ayer Rajah: Friendly Streets Coming to Pandan Gardens

Efforts are underway to introduce Friendly Streets in Pandan Gardens, an initiative aimed at making everyday walking and cycling journeys safer, smoother, and more convenient for the community.

As part of the improvements, a new signalised pedestrian crossing will be introduced in front of Ayer Rajah Community Club to enhance pedestrian safety and accessibility. Residents can also expect additional features such as kerbless crossings and reduced speed limits within the estate to create a more comfortable and people-friendly environment for all.



West Coast: Repair and Redecoration (R&R) at Blocks 506 to 512 West Coast Drive

Enhancement works will be carried out at Blocks 506 to 512 West Coast Drive under the upcoming Repair and Redecoration (R&R) programme to improve the overall living environment within the precinct.

The upgrading works include:

- Repainting of the building façade
- Repair of existing flooring at void decks and corridors
- Replacement of wall and floor tiles at all lift lobbies



Pioneer: Construction of High and Low Linkway from Block 605 Jurong West Street 62 to Polyclinic

To improve accessibility for Pioneer residents, a high- and low-linkway will be constructed to connect Block 605 Jurong West Street 62 to the nearby polyclinic, providing a more direct and sheltered route for residents.

The new linkway aims to provide a more direct, sheltered, and convenient route for residents, especially seniors and those with mobility needs, enhancing ease of access to essential healthcare services.

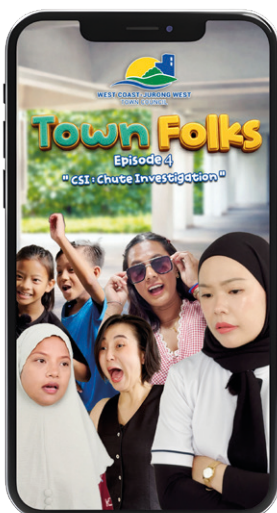
